The **BASS CLEF** (or **F CLEF**) is a symbol which helps identify pitches on the staff. It is usually used for men's voices, low instruments, and the left hand of the piano.



To draw a bass clef:

1. Start on the 4th line of the staff.



2. Circle around and touch the top line of the staff.



3. Stop just below the 2nd line.



4. Place a dot above and below the 4th line of the staff. This marks the line as **F**.
