In 4/4 time, the duration of the notes are as follows:




<u>TERM</u>	<u>NOTE</u>	<u>DURATION</u>
Whole Note		4 beats
Half Note		2 beats
Quarter Note		1 beat
Eighth Note		1/2 beat




When 2 eighth notes appear together they sometimes look like this:  and together equal 1 beat
